

#### Report:



**Topic:** "Creating 3-D Geometrical Shapes"

**Date:** 07-07-2023

**Venue:** Doddagubbi Government School

**Time:** 01:30 to 04:00pm

#### **Aim:**

The primary aim of the DSR activity was to uphold the social responsibility of students by creating a teaching environment for the under privilege school students. It was accomplished by introducing 3D geometric shapes to government school students and foster their spatial thinking abilities. By utilizing innovative teaching techniques and hands-on learning, the activity aimed to make the learning process engaging, interactive and effective.

#### **Objectives:**

- Introduce students to different 3D geometric shapes such as cubes, spheres, cones, cylinders, and pyramids.
- Help students understand the properties and characteristics of each 3D shape.
- Enable students to visualize 3D shapes in a tangible and interactive manner.
- Encourage collaboration and teamwork among the students during the learning process.
- Assess the impact of the activity on students' understanding and engagement with 3D geometric shapes.



#### **Report:**

The DSR activity focused on implementing innovative teaching techniques to introduce 3D geometric shapes to students in government schools.
