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



3. The collaborative nature of the game fostered teamwork and camaraderie among club members, as they worked together to answer questions and complete challenges.




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Brief Report:

- **Blindfolding:** each team had elected one member as the blindfolded participant, who was blindfolded and relied on the guide dance of the teammates to navigate the obstacles.



Then it was Chinese mathematicians who approximated pi value to 7 decimals and later it was Indian mathematicians who finally approximated the pi value to 5 decimals.

The value pi plays a significant role in many fields of geometry, trigonometry and particularly those concerning circles, spheres or ellipses. Other branches like Statistics, Physics, Fourier analysis and Number Theory also include pi in some of their important formulae.

- Don't over promise- Be realistic and honest throughout their campaign and don't make promises they can't keep. If they need a bit of guidance on what's plausible speak to current union officers.





At the end of the event students were able to:




