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



Group Singing by Indian Academy Degree College Autonomous:


Students from Indian Academy Degree College Autonomous came together for a group singing performance, singing patriotic songs that echoed the spirit of freedom and unity.

Speech by Prof. K. S. Suryanarayana:



Broad Aim of the Event: To address the crucial struggle the students face with their self-esteem and encourage them with practical learning techniques which would help in their academics. To explore how self-esteem impacts an individual's ability to learn effectively and make the most of educational opportunities. Additionally, the lecture discusses various learning techniques and strategies that can be employed to enhance self-esteem and optimize the learning process.

Objectives:

1. Strategies and tips to encounter the concept of respecting their feelings and abilities.
2. To enable youth to experience being competent to cope with the basic challenges of life and of being worthy of happiness.
3. Boosting learning techniques by introducing effective learning strategies and study techniques and concept of growth mindset and its role in enhancing learning.

Report:

The lecture on "Self Esteem and Learning Techniques" was addressed by a very esteemed IIM Ahmedabad Alumnus with more than 20 years of proven excellence in Program Management, Business Operations, Service Delivery, Cloud Support, Business Analysis, Research, and Sustainability Development, Dr. Mahesh Pavan Sathavalli.

Self-esteem is the evaluation we make of our own worth and abilities. It can be influenced by internal factors such as self-perception and external factors such as social interactions and feedback. Individuals with high self-esteem tend to be more resilient, motivated, and open to learning. The lecture was divided into three segments- Story telling ,an activity which included role play and presentation with the speaker's insights which were intertwined together to keep the audience engaged in listening.

After the play was acted, he drew conclusions from students stating that the positives which they describe are the expectations from the sale and the weakness are the the inhibitions or the obstacles which is holding them back from the closing of the sale which was an eye opener for all to see themselves in everything they do which in turn affects their self esteem and value in the world around.

The speaker then told a story about a young boy (Swami Vivekananda) who desired to be tonga rider and that his mother asked him to be the rider of five such tonga which abbreviates to-
C- Character K- Knowledge A- Attitude S- Skills H- Habits (C/KASH)

Some of the Effective Learning Techniques:

- To optimize learning, individuals can employ various techniques, including:
- **Active Learning:** Engaging actively with the material through discussions, problem-solving, and practical applications.
- **Effective Time Management:** Prioritizing tasks, setting achievable goals, and maintaining a study schedule.
- **Metacognition:** Reflecting on one's learning process, identifying strengths and weaknesses, and adjusting strategies accordingly.

- Collaborative Learning: Working in groups to foster diverse perspectives and enhance understanding.
- Use of Technology: Leveraging educational tools and resources available online for self-paced learning.



- **Blindfolding:** each team had elected one member as the blindfolded participant, who was blindfolded and relied on the guide dance of the teammates to navigate the obstacles.



- The audience were also excited to answer those questions. Therefore, it created a healthy environment.



Topic: "Creating 3-D Geometrical Shapes"

Date: 07-07-2023

Venue: Doddagubbi Government School

Time: 01:30 to 04:00pm

Aim:

The primary aim of the DSR activity was to uphold the social responsibility of students by creating a teaching environment for the under privilege school students. It was accomplished by introducing 3D geometric shapes to government school students and foster their spatial thinking abilities. By utilizing innovative teaching techniques and hands-on learning, the activity aimed to make the learning process engaging, interactive and effective.

- Assess the impact of the activity on students' understanding and engagement with 3D geometric shapes.




Report:
