


Whilst the pandemic has, and continues to, take its toll on our mental health, the ability to reconnect through World Mental Health Day 2022 will provide us with an opportunity to rekindle our efforts to protect and improve mental health.

Many aspects of mental health have been challenged; and already before the pandemic in 2019 an estimated one in eight people globally were living with a mental disorder. At the same time, the services, skills and funding available for mental health remain in short supply, and fall far below what is needed, especially in low and middle income countries.

The COVID-19 pandemic has created a global crisis for mental health, fueling short- and long-term stresses and undermining the mental health of millions. Estimates put the rise in both anxiety and depressive disorders at more than 25% during the first year of the pandemic. At the same time, mental health services have been severely disrupted and the treatment gap for mental health conditions has widened.

Growing social and economic inequalities, protracted conflicts, violence and public health emergencies affect whole populations, threatening progress towards improved well-being; a staggering 84 million people worldwide were forcibly displaced during 2021. We must deepen the value and commitment we give to mental health as individuals, communities and governments and match that value with more commitment, engagement and investment by all stakeholders, across all sectors. We must strengthen mental health care so that the full spectrum of mental health needs is met through a community-based network of accessible, affordable and quality services and supports.

World Blood Donors day is celebrated as the birthday of an Austrian Physician, Karl Landsteiner who discovered the first three human blood groups in the year 1901.






A total number of 300 NSS students' volunteers have taken part in the event and made it a grand success.

The camp began at 9:00 am with a short inaugural function by Prof. Shalini, Vice Principal of IADC-A and expressed her gratitude to the NSS unit of the college for its continuous endeavour in this respect. She welcomed the medical teams and motivated volunteers. She also Congratulated Prof. Kesavan, NSS coordinator and his team for successfully organizing the eye donation camp and appreciated the activities carried by them for Social cause.

The eye donation process of all the donors was being done by the medical team. The Programme ended at 3.30 pm. All the teachers, students enthusiastically participated. Around 41 pledged their eyes.

A certificate of appreciation, donation card and refreshments were given to donors and volunteers as a token of gratitude.

"The eyes are indeed windows to the world and to our soul". Eye donation is an act of donating one's eyes after his/her death. It is an act of charity, purely for the benefit of the society and is totally voluntary. Every Eye donation can give vision to two people and can decrease the shortage of eye donors. Donated eyes can be used to restore vision in people who are suffering from corneal blindness.

World eye donation day is observed on June 10 every year to encourage people to donate their eyes after death while raising awareness about blindness and visual impairment.

Eyes are one of the most important sensory organs in the human body as it renders vision and the power to see. Hence, it is a noble idea to donate eyes after death of human beings and thus give the power to see the beauty of nature to the needy. In India 4.6 million people are estimated with corneal blindness, which can be treated with corneal implantation which is possible through eye donation programmes.

We thank all those families who took the decision of donating cornea after the demise of their loved ones. Their timely decision remains inspirational for all. We also thank local

governing bodies, hospitals, eye specialists from the region, Government doctors and officials to support the eye donation drive, cornea collection, and subsequent transplant.

Blindness is one of the major public health problems in the developing countries. According to World Health Organization, corneal diseases (damage to the tissue covering the front of eye called cornea) are among the major causes of vision loss and blindness after cataract and glaucoma. Approximately 5% of the world's population is blind due to corneal diseases alone.

In India, approximately 68 lakh people suffer from corneal blindness in at least one eye; of these, 10 lakh people are blind in both their eyes. The National Blindness and Visual Impairment Survey 2019 reported that corneal blindness was the leading cause of blindness among patients aged less than 50 years in India, accounting for 37.5% of the cases and was the second leading cause of blindness among patients above the age of 50 years.

In most cases, loss of sight can be corrected through "Eye Donation". After the death of a person, various organs can be donated and can be surgically transplanted to the patients who need them. One such organ is the eye. By donating eyes after death, a corneal blind person can see again through a surgical procedure known as corneal transplantation, where the damaged cornea is replaced by a healthy cornea from the eye donor.


There are numerous reasons as to why people do not donate their eyes:

- Lack of awareness among the general public
- Insufficient facilities in the institutes and hospitals
- Absence of motivation even among trained personnel
- Social and religious myths

All we need to know about eye donation:

- Eye donation is donating one's eyes after his/her death.
- Only corneal blind people are benefitted from donated eyes.
- Corneal blindness is the loss of sight due to damage in the tissue covering the front of eye called cornea.

- Anyone can donate their eyes irrespective of age, sex and blood group.
- The cornea should be removed within an hour of death.
- Eyes of donated person can save the vision of two corneal blind people.
- Eye removal takes only 10-15 minutes and leaves no scar or disfigurement of the face.
- Donated eyes are never bought or sold. Eye donation is never refused.
- Contact the eye bank to become a registered eye donor.


How Republic Day Celebrated Every Year:





district level cultural festivals are organised every year on this day. It is a custom to have a foreign head of nations as the Chief Guest for the R-Day Parade at the national capital.



AIDS Awareness in IADC-A Campus


A Visit to BBMP Girls High School & Sri Sidhartha Sanivasa High School

Objectives:

- To nurture college students as citizens with moral, ethical and social values so as to provide service to the society through activities and discharge their obligations towards the society.
- To increase comprehensive awareness AIDS-its impact, management and availability of support systems among young school students.
- To induce the spirit to help and support people living with HIV/AIDS thereby reducing stigma and discrimination against PLHWAs.

Department of Microbiology organised AIDS awareness in Indian Academy Degree College-Autonomous on International AIDS day, 1st December, 2021 by pinning red ribbon to staff members and students as red ribbon is a symbol for the fight against AIDS. Following red ribbon pinning, knowledge on modes of transmission, methods of prevention and the latent period of AIDS improved, as did attitudes to the disease was explained. The only question on 'attitudes' which was not significantly different among both groups was: 'fear of AIDS and invulnerability to AIDS', although the intervention students and staff members were found to have better attitudes.

On the same day, Dr. S. Anu Kiruthika and Dr. K Sahithya from the Department of Microbiology, IADC-A and M.Sc., Microbiology students visited BBMP Girls High School & Sri Sidhartha Sanivasa High School, Bengaluru. The HIV/AIDS Awareness Programme content is: Introduction to HIV and AIDS, Where did HIV/AIDS come from?, World Statistics, National Statistics, What are HIV/AIDS, Symptoms of HIV Infection, Stages and symptoms of HIV Infection, Factors influencing disease progression, Main types of HIV transmission, Ways of preventing HIV transmission, Use of condoms, Dynamics of HIV testing, Legal and ethical issues, STIs and Positive Living.



Most of the students were happy to have an AIDS education programme in their school. This may be because the sessions were interesting and active participation was encouraged. Different methods were employed to improve students' knowledge and practices of AIDS. Also, it was the first time they would be addressed on a health issue or by a health care provider in the school and it was a welcome addition to the normal school routine. The questionnaire addressed the following issues (1) socio-demographic characteristics, (2) knowledge on the transmission and prevention of AIDS, (3) attitudes to the disease and individuals with the disease, (4) sexual practices including use of the condom, and (5) suggestions for the education programme, i.e. topics to be addressed.

The suggestions of the students reflected that they found the programme beneficial, and were concerned about how it could be sustained and extended to more schools. The need to train people living with HIV/AIDS to speak to the public on AIDS is highlighted, as some students refused to be convinced that the disease existed unless they saw an infected person.

The principal and teachers participated in some of the sessions. A number of activities were organized not only to mark the significance of maintaining good health but also for causes & prevention of AIDS. They were also involved in reviewing the essay and in the debates. This was done during the literary and debating periods off the school period. It was a new experience to most of the students; the role-plays and songs composed are still sung by the students. Although the intervention was half day, the college students' interaction in the school was for much longer. Staff members were available to refer students and teachers with reproductive health problems to the appropriate clinics. This was done in a sympathetic and in a non-judgemental manner.

Outcome of the visit:

School students benefited from awareness programme that transmit important information necessary to prevent risky behaviour, and improve knowledge and attitudes on HIV/AIDS.






The cultural program like Drama, Fashion show, group singing and dance was rendered to the soldiers, who spend their lives separated from friends and family, in their service to our nation.




